

The House Project

an exhibition of site specific and site related installations

The House Project is an initiative of nine women (7 artists and 2 writers) Madeleine Lamont, Christine Ho Ping Kong, Suzy Schlanger, Shanna Miller, Penelope Stewart, Lois Andison, Siobhan Gray, Claire Christie and Sylvie Fortin. This collective of women artists and writers hopes to push the boundaries of site specific/site related installation by involving themselves in this ambitious project. The "house" is the venue for this exhibition and is not solely an alternative site but is the armature for a discourse on the domestic; the "house" being encoded with cultural and social meaning, as has each room. This building functions as the connecting rod - a metaphor for the dramas that take place within it. Each artist will have a room in which to resurrect latent memories or layer her own personal imprint.

From May 16 through June 10, 1994 each artist will participate in a residency and will begin to live/work in the house chosen for the exhibition. The installations will be completed by June 11, 1994 at which time the exhibition will officially open to the public and run through until July 16, 1994. Each Sunday tours will be given by participating artists from 2 pm.
